M&As		
Three options were discussed for the amendment to the M&As, as the current M&As are not reflecting what we do at present. The options were explained in the document provided by WF and GR:		
Foundation Model, Associated Model and Mixed Model		
Following some discussion it was agreed that initially we would go with the Foundation Model, reflecting the current mode of operation, but with options in the wording that could enable the Mixed Model to be adopted without further wording changes at a later date. Consideration of whether to adopt the workings of a Mixed Model is to be deferred until later next year. GR and WF to

It was further agreed that the pursuit of corporate membership should be channelled through the Friends. GP agreed to look into this.
